A REMINDER OF WHAT THE HORECA4VET PROJECT IS ALL ABOUT...

HoReCa4VET is a European project that aims to develop a validation and certification model that will be the necessary material for the design of future courses and training programmes and that will, in turn, constitute a catalogue of competences for those people who want to develop, acquire and validate qualifications in the HORECA sector.

In short, it is a project that brings vocational training closer to the reality of the HORECA industry, an increasingly competitive and specialised sector

The result includes the development of training in the work environment, cascading, flexible learning paths, activating didactic methods, modern, innovative methods teaching taking into account the specifics of Horeca.

Great emphasis will be placed on the individualisation of training, active and practical learning methods, solutions in organisation and didactics.

In addition, intellectual output 2 consists of:

- 1. The methodology of developing curricula and educational packages.
- 2. A training programme/packages with an indication of possibility to achieve the learning outcomes through distance learning and stationary education (in English).
- 3. An improved, final training programme/packages (in English and national languages of the partner countries).



TRANSNATIONAL MEETING IN VALENCIA

On **1-2 September** 2022, the **third face-to-face transnational meeting** took place at the offices of **Fundación Equipo Humano**, in **Valencia** (Spain).

During the meeting, the partners reviewed the second intellectual output, as well as discussed the progress of the following results, some of which are already in full development phase.

Mainly, the meeting focused on how to **integrate the developed training materials into the interactive e-learning platform** and how to make them visually attractive and accessible to the end-user.

The platform, which corresponds to the fifth intellectual output, is divided into two sections: validation and certification.





UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

The next steps to follow are:

- ⇒ Transnational meeting in Antalya (Turkey) on 3-4 November 2022.
- ⇒ Continue with the development of outputs 3, 4 and 5, concerning the validation and certification models, as well as the e-learning platform including the materials previously developed.
- ⇒ Proceed with the organisation of the multiplier events in each partner country.
- ⇒ Plan and organise the Final Conference of the project, which will take place in Krakow (Poland) in March 2023.





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
