









The European project "HoReCa4VET - Market qualifications - a signpost for minimising competence gaps between education and the labour market in the HoReCa sector" is developing a competence validation and certification model for those who want to develop, acquire and validate qualifications in the HORECA sector.

Outcomes achieved

Since the start of the project in October 2020 until now, we have been able to successfully obtain the first two results of the project, i.e. a comparative analysis of validation and certification models based on the experience of international partnership for the HORECA sector; as well as a curricula and educational packages for the HORECA sector.

What are we working on?

The consortium is currently focusing on the development of an interactive e-learning platform, divided into validation and certification; as well as on such validation and certification models for professional qualifications in the HORECA sector.

It is expected to be ready before the end of 2022, in order to proceed with multiplier events that will allow participants to experience HoReCa4VET first hand by testing the results obtained during the last two years.

Next steps

The HoReCa4VET partners expect, on the one hand, to produce a series of scientific publications on the HORECA topic and have them ready by the first quarter of 2023. This would be the final output of the project.

On the other hand, we are already starting to organise the Final Conference, which will be held in Poland on 9-10 March 2023, hosted by our partner EVACO Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością.

Once we have all the results, who will be able to benefit from them?

Direct beneficiaries are people who are undergoing training or are interested in training in the HORECA sector.

Other beneficiaries will be: VET schools, employees of companies, employees of institutions dealing with the development, validation and confirmation of vocational qualifications and competences; sectoral and local governmental organisations, Human Resources specialists, and professional and personal counsellors.
